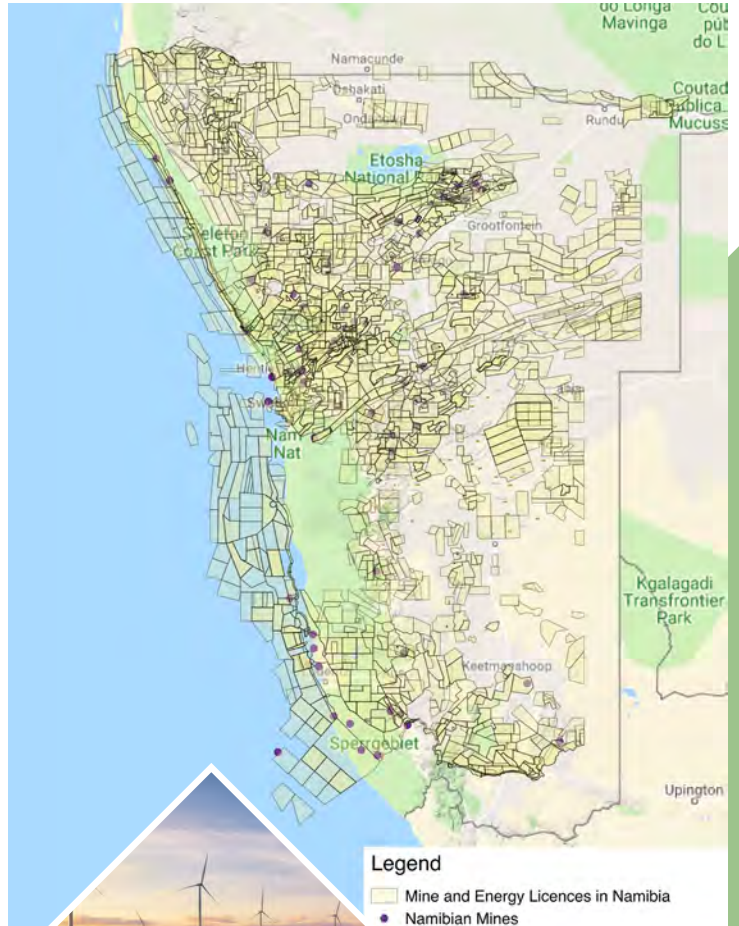
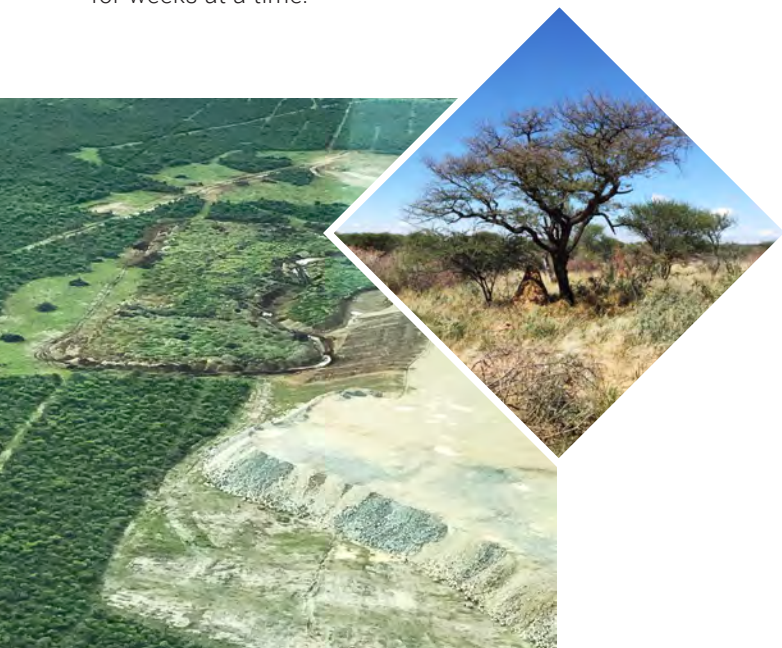
## AGRICULTURE & FORESTRY
