Location of ML 129 and ML 133:

Both Mining licences are located within the the Daures Constituency in the Erongo Region. ML 129 covers an area of approximately 4868 hectares and is located approximately 15 km on the Uis- Henties Bay C35 district road, southwest of the Uis town. ML 133 covers an area of approximately 3288 hectares and is located along the banks of the ephemeral Omaruru River, approximately 45 km south of the Uis town, in the Nai Nais community. For reference, the locality maps for ML 129 and ML 133 are presented in appendix A and B.

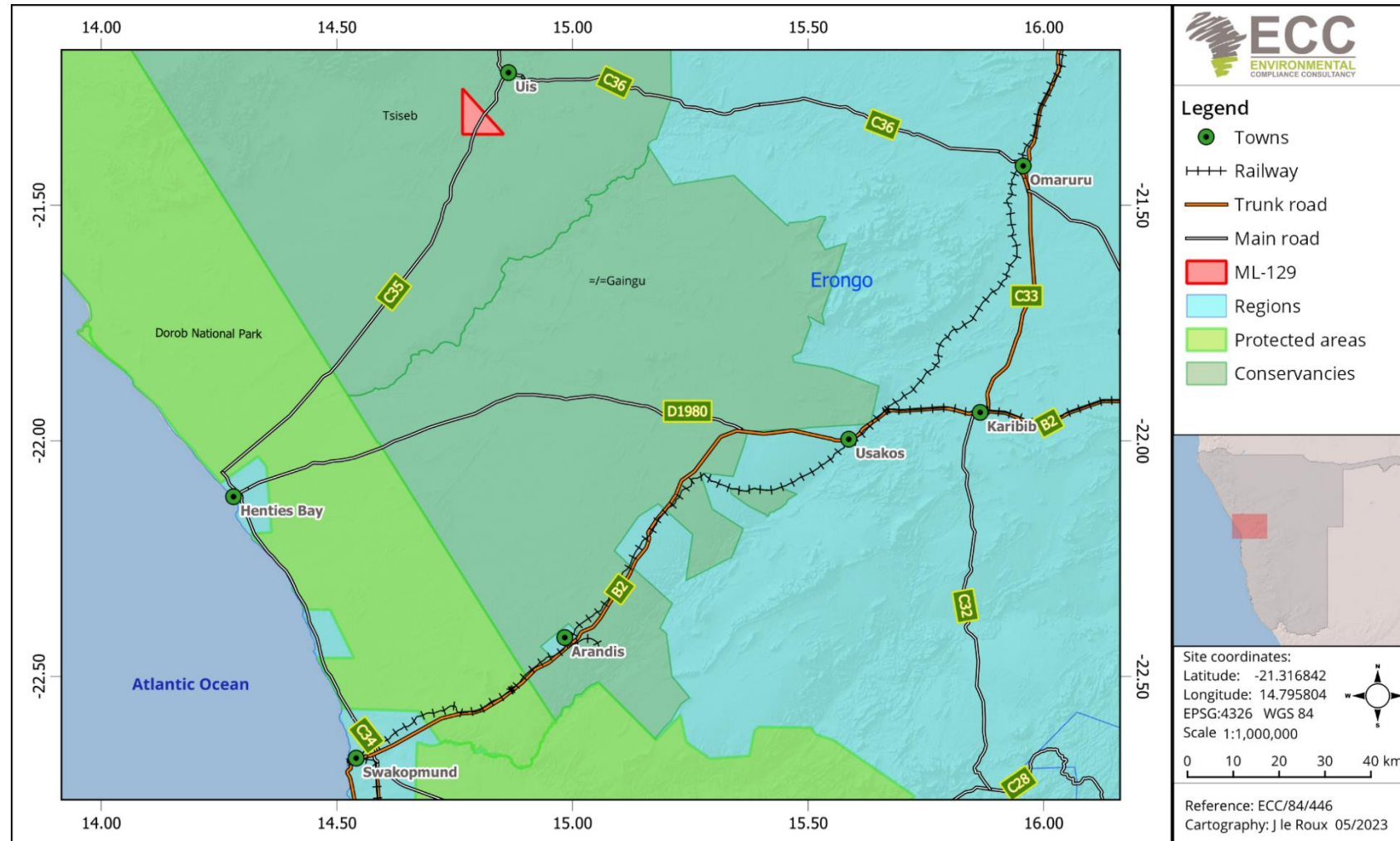
